



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DOG OWNERS

**DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD WHILST ON THE PARK.**

**Dogs are NOT permitted into the field with the bar, swimming pool and play area;  
or any facility buildings**

**Walk & exercise your dog OFF the park, as indicated on the map over the page**

The stile at the top of the 'Grove' gives access to the back lane: Go right to access footpaths across the Mendip hills – or go left, crossing the main road and down into Rodney Stoke to access footpaths, back lanes and the nature reserve. These routes will take you to beautiful areas that you can both enjoy.



**Do not allow your dog to disturb other campers by barking**

**Never leave your dog unattended in cars, tents or caravans**  
as we do not have facilities to retain any dog found roaming



**Clean up after your dog & use the dog waste bin**

### Extra information!

Please use the dog waste bin provided in the top field;  
ours are biodegradable and are provided free of charge from reception.

A footpath map is printed on the back of this information, please stick to the designated footpaths across private fields.

**We do not recommend walking on the main A371 road as there are no pavements.**

Take extra care when walking in fields with cattle – stay clear and take a wide berth.

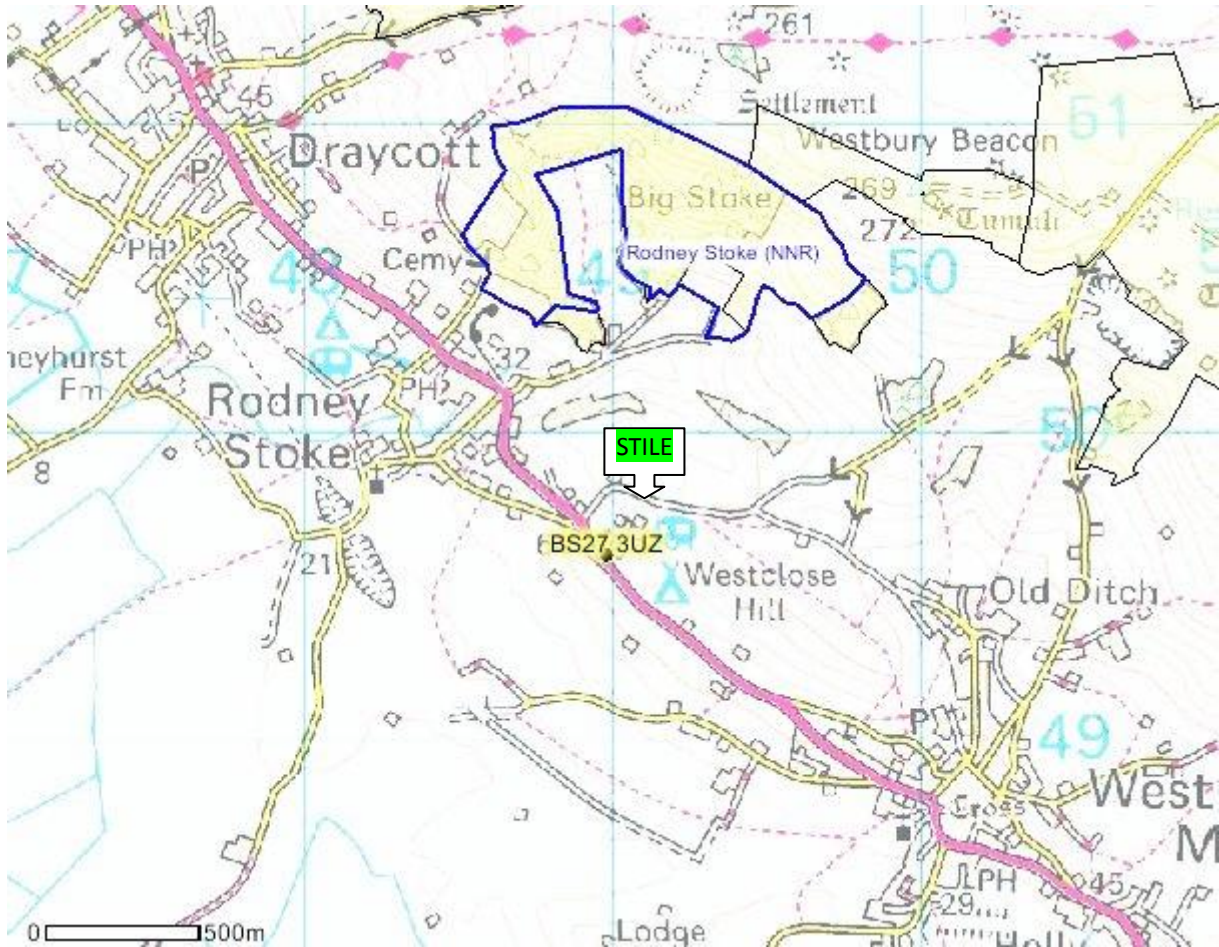
Dogs are permitted in Cheddar Gorge & Caves, but not Wookey Hole Caves.

█ Main Road A371 – we do not recommend walking on the main road as there is no footpath.

█ Lanes

PH – public house – the Rodney Stoke Inn is within an easy 15 minute walk (uphill on the way back though) and has a large menu, lovely garden with a small play area and dogs welcome outside. A torch is recommended for the return journey at night.
